This March, the church's Christian school administration decided to have the bilingual students attend the Seminary Chapel on Fridays. Previously, they had their own chapel once a week and Bible class. Now, they have all three. This has already been fruitful for the students in that one of the seventh grade students of the bilingual school accepted Christ after one of the messages. I believe that another seventh grade student named Isaac still has not accepted Christ yet, as well as many others. Continue praying that God uses these set aside times for preaching to work on the hearts of these students to come to Christ.

God has been manifesting His goodness to us in providing meetings for deputation this June. We now are planning to start in Minnesota and to stay for less than a month. God has allowed us to schedule a total of 7 meetings already. Please continue to pray that God gives us a full schedule for our deputation. Prayer really works as we have seen over and over again. Accordingly, thank you all so much for your support by prayer specifically. We have been so blessed by our faithful and good God!
