One day as we traveled from Michigan, we were specifically praying for gas lower than \$4. Our gas light had been on for a while, so we had to stop at a gas station priced \$4.14. We were able to pass out some tracts as we filled up the tank, and I was able to share the Gospel with a Catholic lady. As we were about to leave, she came to us and gave us \$20! Calculating the expense as we left, we realize that God provided gas at \$2.60 a gallon! This is just one of many stories where God has proven Himself so caring, even in the little things.

Praise be to God, there have several more churches and individuals which have taken us on for support, and we are now at 38%. Our prayer is to be at 50% by the beginning of January. We wanted to specifically thank those of you who prayed for us to get more support and more meetings, because the day after we sent our last prayer letter, and several days following, we got more calls than usual answering those specific requests!
