Celina and Julianne are doing great, and they even got to be in church on Wednesday! Please fervently pray with us that she would be saved at a young age and grow up to serve and love the Lord with all of her heart, soul, mind, and strength! We are so excited that Julianne is going to get to be a little missionary as part of our family- we have already been talking to her about

Mozambique and all that the Lord wants to do there! We are eagerly waiting for her birth certificate and social security card to come in in order to start her passport process. These two documents alone could take several weeks, and the passport could take several months. On top of that, the actual visa process cannot be started till these 3 arrive. *Please pray for FAST paperwork- we know however that the length of this process is entirely in God's hands, and His timing is always best!* That being said, we are thrilled to announce that **we are now at 90% seen, 100% promised! Praise the Lord!!!** As we wait for the paperwork, we will still be presenting in churches raising additional funds/support for the ministry. Please pray that we can be a blessing to these churches and that we will do His will.

Also, just several days before Julianne's birth, we were able to be a part of a VBS at one of our supporting churches here in MN- what a blessing! Luke had the privilege of sharing a lesson with the kids each night, and there were several who received Christ as their Savior! *Pray for these kids to get Scripturally baptized, to grow in the Lord, and for their parents to believe on Christ as their Savior if they have not and come to church there faithfully.* My neighbor is not saved and found he has an aneurism; also, his daughter just got in an accident. *Pray for her health, his salvation, any unsaved family*.
